DAY 1 - DEPARTURE | OVERNIGHT FLIGHT

Pilgrims will begin this spiritual journey with a pilgrims' Mass at St. Ambrose Catholic Church in Annandale, Virginia, followed by motorcoach transportation to Washington Dulles International Airport. From Dulles, we will depart on an overnight nonstop flight to Lisbon, Portugal, with meals served onboard as we begin our pilgrimage through the holy sites of Portugal, Spain, and France.

DAY 2 - LISBON TO FATIMA

Upon arrival in Lisbon, Portugal, pilgrims will begin exploring the rich Catholic heritage of this historic city with visits to Belém Tower, Jerónimos Monastery, Lisbon Cathedral, and the Church of St. Anthony, the birthplace of St. Anthony of Padua, one of the Church's most beloved saints. Following our time in Lisbon, we will transfer to Fatima, the site of Our Lady's appearances to the three shepherd children in 1917. After arriving in Fatima, pilgrims will check into the hotel, enjoy dinner, and prepare for our time of prayer and reflection at this beloved Marian shrine.

DAY 3 - FATIMA

Today we will spend a full day in Fatima, one of the most beloved Marian shrines in the Catholic world. Here, pilgrims will have the opportunity for prayer and reflection at the site where Our Lady appeared to three shepherd children—St. Francisco and St. Jacinta Marto, and their cousin Lucia dos Santos—in 1917, delivering her message of prayer, penance, and conversion. Pilgrims will have time to visit the

shrine, pray at the Chapel of the Apparitions, venerate the tombs of the shepherd children, and participate in the spiritual atmosphere of this holy place.

DAY 4 - FATIMA | COIMBRA | SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

After breakfast, we will depart Fatima and travel to Coimbra, where we will visit the Monastery of Santa Clara-a-Nova, the burial place of St. Elizabeth of Portugal, a beloved queen known for her deep faith, humility, and works of charity. If arrangements permit, pilgrims may also have the opportunity to visit the Carmel of Coimbra, associated with the Carmelite sisters and the spiritual heritage of this historic city.

We will then continue our journey into Spain to Santiago de Compostela, one of the greatest pilgrimage destinations in the Catholic world. Upon arrival, we will visit the magnificent Cathedral of Santiago de Compostela, where pilgrims have gathered for more than a thousand years to venerate the tomb of St. James the Greater, Apostle. After our visit, we will check into our hotel, enjoy dinner, and spend the night in this historic pilgrimage city.

DAY 5 - SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA | ASTORGA | LEÓN | BURGOS

After breakfast, we will depart Santiago de Compostela and continue our pilgrimage through the ancient Catholic heartland of northern Spain, traveling to Astorga, one of Spain's oldest dioceses. Here we will visit the Episcopal Palace of Astorga, designed by the renowned architect Antoni

Gaudí, whose Catholic faith deeply influenced his work, as well as the nearby Cathedral of Santa María of Astorga, the mother church of the Diocese of Astorga. Together, these sacred sites reflect the deep Catholic heritage of this historic city along the Camino de Santiago.

We will then continue to León, where we will visit the Basilica of San Isidoro, one of Spain's most important Romanesque churches and the resting place of St. Isidore of Seville, Doctor of the Church. After our visit and celebration of Mass, we will continue to Burgos for our hotel, dinner, and overnight stay.

DAY 6 - BURGOS | AZPEITIA | LOURDES

After breakfast, pilgrims will visit the magnificent Cathedral of Burgos, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of Spain's greatest Gothic masterpieces. We will continue to the Basque region to visit the Shrine of Our Lady of Aránzazu, a cherished Marian sanctuary, followed by Azpeitia, the birthplace of St. Ignatius of Loyola. At the Sanctuary of Loyola, pilgrims will reflect on the life and conversion of the founder of the Jesuits and one of the Church's greatest missionaries.

Our journey continues to Lourdes, France, where Our Lady appeared to St. Bernadette Soubirous in 1858. Upon arrival, pilgrims will check into the hotel, enjoy dinner, and prepare for prayer at the Grotto of Massabielle.

DAY 7 - LOURDES

Today we will immerse ourselves in the spiritual beauty of Lourdes, one of the world's most beloved Marian shrines. We will begin with Mass at or near the Grotto of Massabielle, where Our Lady appeared to St. Bernadette Soubirous in 1858, followed by a guided visit of the Sanctuary, including the Grotto, basilicas, and Baths.

During free time, pilgrims will have opportunities for prayer and devotion, including visiting the Grotto, participating in the Water Gesture or baths, praying the Rosary, receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation, and spending time in quiet reflection. The day will conclude with the Blessed Sacrament Procession, Benediction of the Sick, and the moving Marian Torchlight Procession at the Grotto.

DAY 8 - LOURDES

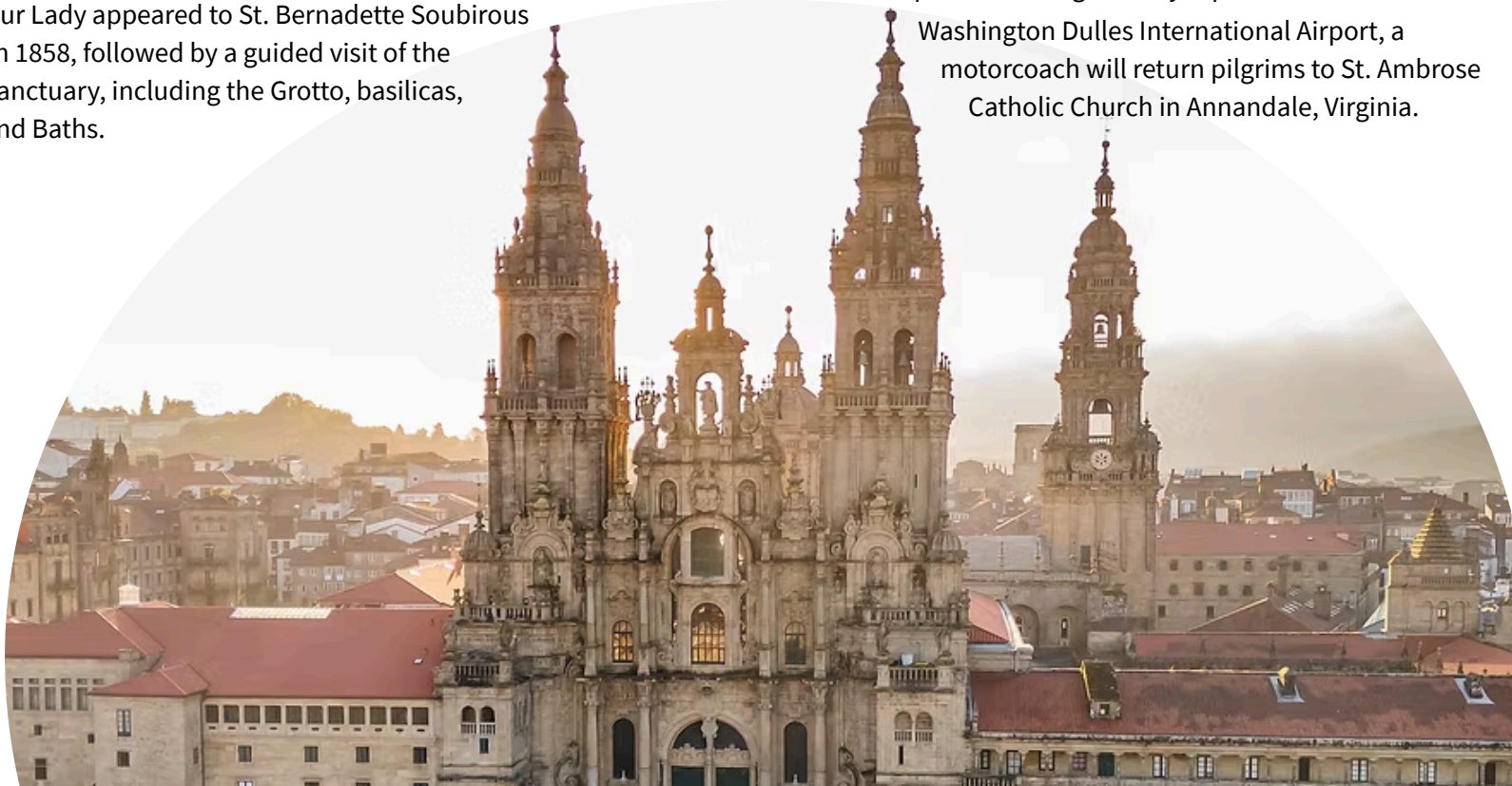
After breakfast, we will celebrate Mass before following the life of St. Bernadette Soubirous through a guided walking tour of Lourdes. Pilgrims will visit key sites connected to her life and the apparitions, including the Boly Mill, where she was born, the Cachot, where her family lived during difficult years, and other places that reveal the story of the young visionary chosen by Our Lady.

Pilgrims will have time for personal prayer and devotion, with opportunities to return to the Grotto, pray the Stations of the Cross, spend time in Adoration, or visit the Baths. The day will conclude with the Blessed Sacrament Procession, Benediction of the Sick, our final pilgrims' dinner, and the Marian Torchlight Rosary Procession with pilgrims from around the world.

DAY 9 - RETURN HOME

After an early breakfast, pilgrims will depart Lourdes by motorcoach for Toulouse-Blagnac Airport and our return flight home, carrying with us the many graces received throughout this pilgrimage—from the messages of Our Lady at Fatima and Lourdes to the witness of the saints and the bonds of prayer and fellowship shared along the way. Upon arrival at

Washington Dulles International Airport, a motorcoach will return pilgrims to St. Ambrose Catholic Church in Annandale, Virginia.
