

## DAY 1 - DEPARTURE

After a Pilgrims' Mass at Sacred Heart parish in La Plata, transfer by Keller coach bus to Dulles International Airport to catch a 6:25pm United Airlines nonstop flight to Paris for a 7:45am arrival at Charles de Gaulle Airport.

## DAY 2 - PARIS

Upon arriving at Charles de Gaulle Airport, you will transfer into Paris to visit the Shrine of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal, where St. Catherine Labouré rests incorrupt. We then walk to the Church of Saint Vincent de Paul to pray before his remains. Enjoy free time for lunch in the Latin Quarter before visiting the iconic Cathedral of Notre Dame. After a brief visit and prayer, we depart for Lisieux for dinner and an overnight stay at the hotel.

## DAY 3 - LISIEUX | NORMANDY

After breakfast in Lisieux, begin your day reflecting on the life of St. Thérèse. Mass will be celebrated at the Basilica of St. Thérèse, where her parents, Saints Louis and Zélie Martin, rest in the crypt. Afterward, visit Les Buissonnets, her childhood home with her relics and belongings, and then the Carmelite Convent where she entered in 1888 and where she is buried. In the afternoon, travel to the Normandy Landing Beaches and the Normandy American Cemetery and Memorial to honor and pray for the soldiers who gave their lives in World War II. You will then continue to Mont Saint-Michel for dinner and an overnight stay, with views of the monastery dedicated to St. Michael the Archangel.



## DAY 4 - MONT SAINT-MICHEL

After an early breakfast, visit Mont Saint-Michel, home to the magnificent monastery known as “The Wonder of the Western World.” Surrounded by a vast tidal bay, it offers breathtaking views. Built in 709 at the request of St. Michael the Archangel, the abbey has hosted a monastic community since the ninth century and has long drawn pilgrims seeking to deepen their faith. After your visit, continue on to Cholet for dinner and an overnight stay at your hotel.

## DAY 5 - SAINT-LAURENT-SUR-SÈVRE

After breakfast, take a short drive to Saint-Laurent-sur-Sèvre to learn about the lives and works of Saint Louis de Montfort and Blessed Marie-Louise Trichet. St. Louis de Montfort’s deep Marian devotion and his teaching on total consecration greatly influenced the Church, including St. John Paul II, whose motto Totus Tuus was inspired by his spirituality. After this visit, continue on to Lourdes for dinner and an overnight stay at your hotel.

## DAY 6 - LOURDES

Today, you will remain in the peaceful town of Lourdes, nestled in the foothills of the Pyrenees. Here you will pray and reflect at the site of Our Lady’s apparitions, where in 1858 the Blessed Virgin appeared to young Bernadette Soubirous as “The Immaculate Conception.” Bernadette prayed the Rosary with Our Lady, who later spoke of God’s love and called for penance and conversion. While in Lourdes, you may attend Mass at the Grotto, drink from the miraculous spring, and participate in the water gesture or baths. Each evening, after dinner, you may join the candlelight Rosary procession before retiring for the night.

## DAY 7 - LOURDES

Enjoy a second full day in Lourdes with a guided tour of sites connected to St. Bernadette, followed by Mass. After lunch on your own, spend a free afternoon experiencing Lourdes— participate in the Water Gesture or baths, pray at the Grotto, visit the churches, or walk the life-size Stations of the Cross overlooking Massabielle. You may also visit Boly Mill, her birthplace, and the “Cachot,” the former prison where her family once lived. At 5:00 p.m., join the Blessed Sacrament Procession, Adoration, and the Blessing of the Sick in the St. Pius X Underground Basilica. The day concludes with dinner and the candlelight Rosary procession before your final night in Lourdes.

## DAY 8 - CONQUES

After breakfast, depart for the medieval village of Conques, an important and beautiful stop along the Camino de Santiago. Visit the Abbey Church of Sainte-Foy, a Romanesque masterpiece that has inspired pilgrims for centuries. Here you will venerate Saint Foy, a fourth-century martyr whose relics, enshrined in the famed golden reliquary, continue to inspire devotion. You will celebrate Mass at the Abbey, then enjoy lunch in the charming village. Afterward, continue on to Issoire to check into your hotel for dinner and a restful evening.

## DAY 9 - NEVERS

After breakfast, depart for Nevers, where St. Bernadette Soubirous spent the last twelve years of her life with the Sisters of Charity of Nevers. Despite frail health and intense suffering, she bore her trials with deep faith and humility until her peaceful death in 1879 at age thirty-five. Today, her incorrupt body rests in the Chapel of St. Gildard, preserved since her death as a sign of her sanctity. You will have time for prayer on the convent grounds before continuing to Paray-le-Monial to check into your hotel for dinner and rest.

## DAY 10 - PARAY-LE-MONIAL | ARS

After breakfast, visit the Sanctuary of St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in Paray-le-Monial, where Jesus revealed the devotion to His Sacred Heart, saying, “Behold this Heart which has so loved men...” Your visit includes the Chapel of the Apparitions, the room with her relics, the Diorama of St. Margaret Mary, the Eucharistic Museum, the Basilica of the Sacred Heart, and the Chapel of St. Claude de la Colombière, where his incorrupt body rests. Afterward, depart for Ars for lunch and a visit to the Shrine of St. Jean-Marie Vianney, seeing his presbytery and the Basilica that holds his incorrupt body. You will then continue to Annecy, the “Venice of the Alps,” for dinner and an overnight stay.

## DAY 11 - ANNECY

This morning, visit the Basilica of the Visitation in Annecy, where the bodies of St. Francis de Sales and St. Jane Frances de Chantal are venerated. St. Francis, the gentle Bishop of Geneva, was known for his deep faith and his patient efforts to heal religious division. In 1604, St. Jane met St. Francis and recognized him as the spiritual guide she had seen in a vision. Their friendship led to the founding of the Order of the Visitation in 1610. Despite many challenges, St. Jane established sixty-nine convents, creating a community that welcomed women often refused by other orders. After this visit, enjoy dinner and a restful night at your hotel in Annecy.

## DAY 12 - RETURN HOME

Depart the hotel and transfer to Geneva Airport for your 10:30 nonstop United Airlines flight to IAD. You will arrive at 14:20, where a Keller coach bus will meet you and return you to Sacred Heart Parish.
