## **DAY 1 - DEPARTURE | OVERNIGHT FLIGHT**

After a pilgrimage Mass at a St. Mary's County parish, transfer by motorcoach to Dulles International Airport to catch an evening nonstop flight for a morning arrival in Rome.

## **DAY 2 - MONTE CASSINO | NETTUNO**

Arriving early in Rome, we travel by motorcoach to the Abbey of Monte Cassino, birthplace of Western monasticism, where we honor St. Benedict and St. Scholastica and reflect on their enduring legacy of prayer and community. In the afternoon, we journey east to Nettuno to visit the Shrine of St. Maria Goretti for time of prayer and reflection, before continuing to Pomezia for dinner and overnight.

## **DAY 3 - ROME | PAPAL AUDIENCE**

Begin the day by attending the Papal Audience, joining pilgrims from around the world to experience the joy of the universal Church and receive the Holy Father's blessing. We then travel to the Colosseum area for lunch, followed by a guided visit to Rome's most iconic ancient monument, reflecting on the witness of early Christian martyrs. In the afternoon, we visit several of Rome's treasured churches, including the Basilica of Saints Cosmas and Damian with its stunning early Christian mosaic, the Chiesa del Gesù, mother church of the Jesuits and resting place of St. Ignatius of Loyola, and the Church of Sant'Ignazio, honoring St. John Berchmans, St. Aloysius Gonzaga, and St. Robert Bellarmine before gathering for dinner and reflection.

## **DAY 4 - ROME**

Visit two of Rome's great papal basilicas: St. Paul Outside the Walls, built over the tomb of St. Paul, and Santa Maria Maggiore, one of the Church's most important Marian shrines. After free time for lunch near the Pantheon, we continue with visits to Santa Maria sopra Minerva, Sant'Agostino, and the Chiesa Nuova, associated with St. Philip Neri, before concluding the day with dinner and fellowship in Rome.

## **DAY 5 - ROME | ST. PETER'S BASILICA**

Begin the day with early morning Mass at St. Peter's Basilica, followed by extended free time for prayer, reflection, and lunch in the Vatican area. In the afternoon, we visit St. John Lateran, the cathedral of the Bishop of Rome, along with the nearby Scala Sancta and the Basilica of Santa Croce in Gerusalemme, before concluding with the Church of the Sacred Heart of Suffrage and its Museum of the Holy Souls of Purgatory. Dinner and overnight in Rome conclude this spiritually rich day.

## **DAY 6 - ROME | ORVIETO | ASSISI**

We conclude our time in Rome with Mass and a visit to the Basilica of Santa Cecilia in Trastevere, built over the martyr's home and burial place. We then travel to Orvieto to visit its magnificent cathedral and the relics of the Eucharistic Miracle of Bolsena, before continuing to Assisi to visit the Basilica of St. Mary of the Angels and the Porziuncola. Dinner and overnight in Assisi conclude this faith-filled day.

## **DAY 7 - ASSISI**

After waking in Assisi, we visit the Basilica of St. Clare, where St. Clare rests and the original San Damiano Crucifix is preserved, followed by the Basilica of St. Francis with its stunning frescoes and the saint's tomb. We then visit the sanctuary of Blessed Carlo Acutis before enjoying free time in Assisi for prayer or exploration, concluding the day with dinner together.

## **DAY 8 - LORETO | LANCIANO**

We begin the day with a drive to Loreto, visiting the Holy House preserved within the Basilica of the Holy House, a cherished Marian shrine that invites reflection on the Incarnation and Mary's faithful "yes." We then continue to Lanciano to visit the site of the Eucharistic Miracle, a powerful witness to the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist. After time for prayer, we travel to San Giovanni Rotondo for dinner and overnight, concluding a day marked by profound encounters with Christ.

## **DAY 9 - SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO | MONTE SANT'ANGELO | MATERDOMINI**

The morning begins in San Giovanni Rotondo with a visit to the Shrine of St. Padre Pio, where pilgrims pray at his tomb and reflect on his witness of mercy and trust in God. We then travel by motorcoach to Monte Sant'Angelo to visit the Cave of St. Michael the Archangel, praying in this ancient and sacred grotto. Continuing to Materdomini, we visit the shrine of St. Gerard Majella before traveling to Pompeii for dinner and overnight, concluding a day rich in prayer and powerful saints.

## **DAY 10 - POMPEII | MUGNANO DEL CARDINALE | PAGANI | SALERNO**

The day starts in Pompeii with a visit to the Sanctuary of the Madonna del Rosario, honoring St. Bartolo Longo and reflecting on the power of the Rosary. We then travel to Mugnano del Cardinale to venerate St. Philomena, followed by lunch. In the afternoon, we visit the Shrine of St. Alphonsus Liguori in Pagani and the Cathedral of St. Matthew in Salerno before continuing to Naples for dinner and overnight, concluding a day rich in saints and devotion.

## **DAY 11 - NAPLES**

We spend the day exploring the rich Christian heritage of Naples, beginning at the Naples Cathedral, home to the relics of St. Januarius, followed by visits to the Catacombs of San Gennaro and San Gaudioso, powerful witnesses to the city's early Christian faith. We then visit the Sansevero Chapel, renowned for its extraordinary artistry, and conclude at the Basilica and Monastery Complex of Santa Chiara, whose peaceful cloister offers a moment of reflection. At the end of the day, we transfer to Pomezia to check into our hotel and enjoy our final dinner together.

## **DAY 12 - RETURN HOME**

Depart Rome on a flight to Washington Dulles. After landing, a motorcoach will meet the group and return you to the parish from which you set out, completing your pilgrimage together.
